

**Sharing Health Information**  
**Survey Questions**  
**July 23, 2012**

**Objective**

This short survey is designed to gauge consumer attitudes toward sharing health information.

**Description**

This 20-question survey takes about five minutes to complete. It attempts to answer these questions:

1. Are consumers willing to share genomic, medical and health tracking information for research purposes?
2. Do consumers have interest in receiving recommendations based on sharing personal health information?

The survey will be hosted by Traitwise ([www.traitwise.com](http://www.traitwise.com)). Responses to the survey are anonymous and cannot be personally identified.

**Survey Questions**

For the questions below, a “Yes” response to the follow question will also trigger questions in bold: **I am willing to share my health and medical information. Y/N**

1. Under the right circumstances, I would be willing to share the following health and medical information... Genomic data, Electronic medical records, Medications, Diet, Exercise, Traits (for example, eye color), Fitness tracking information (Fitbit, wireless scale, etc.), Diseases and conditions, Other
2. I own one or more health/fitness tracking devices (Fitbit or other activity tracking device, Wireless scale, Blood pressure cuff, Zeo or other sleep monitoring device, Blood glucose monitor, etc.), Other
3. I see my doctor as... Godlike, Just another person
4. I have been genotyped through a company like 23andMe, Navigenics, Pathway Genomics, etc.... Yes, No
5. **I am motivated to share my health information for these reasons... Desire to change current system, Make new health discoveries, Learn more about my ancestry, Health condition, Bragging rights, Want something in return, Learn more about personal health risks**
6. **I am willing to share my health and medical information with... Non-profit research organizations (for example, National Psoriasis Foundation), For-profit companies, Universities and academic institutions, Insurance companies, Government, Personal physician or healthcare provider, Family members, Others**

7. I am willing to let researchers use my information if it is irreversibly anonymized... No, In some cases, Yes
- 8. I would share my health and medical information even if it were not anonymized... No, In some cases, Yes**
9. For research purposes, I believe that access to anonymized medical data should be controlled by... Non-profit organizations, Universities and academic institutions, Insurance companies, Government, National databanks, For-profit companies, Myself
10. I would be more likely to share my health and medical information if I received personalized recommendations based on discoveries made from my data... Less likely, More likely
11. I am concerned that anonymized health and medical information will be re-identified... Not concerned, Very concerned

15. My concern with sharing my genomic data is... Insurance discrimination, Employment discrimination, Personal or family privacy, Racial discrimination, Other
16. I would be more likely or less likely to share my health and medical information if I received money for it... Less likely, More likely
17. I would be more likely or less likely to share my health and medical information for research if my physician told me it was safe... Less likely, More likely
