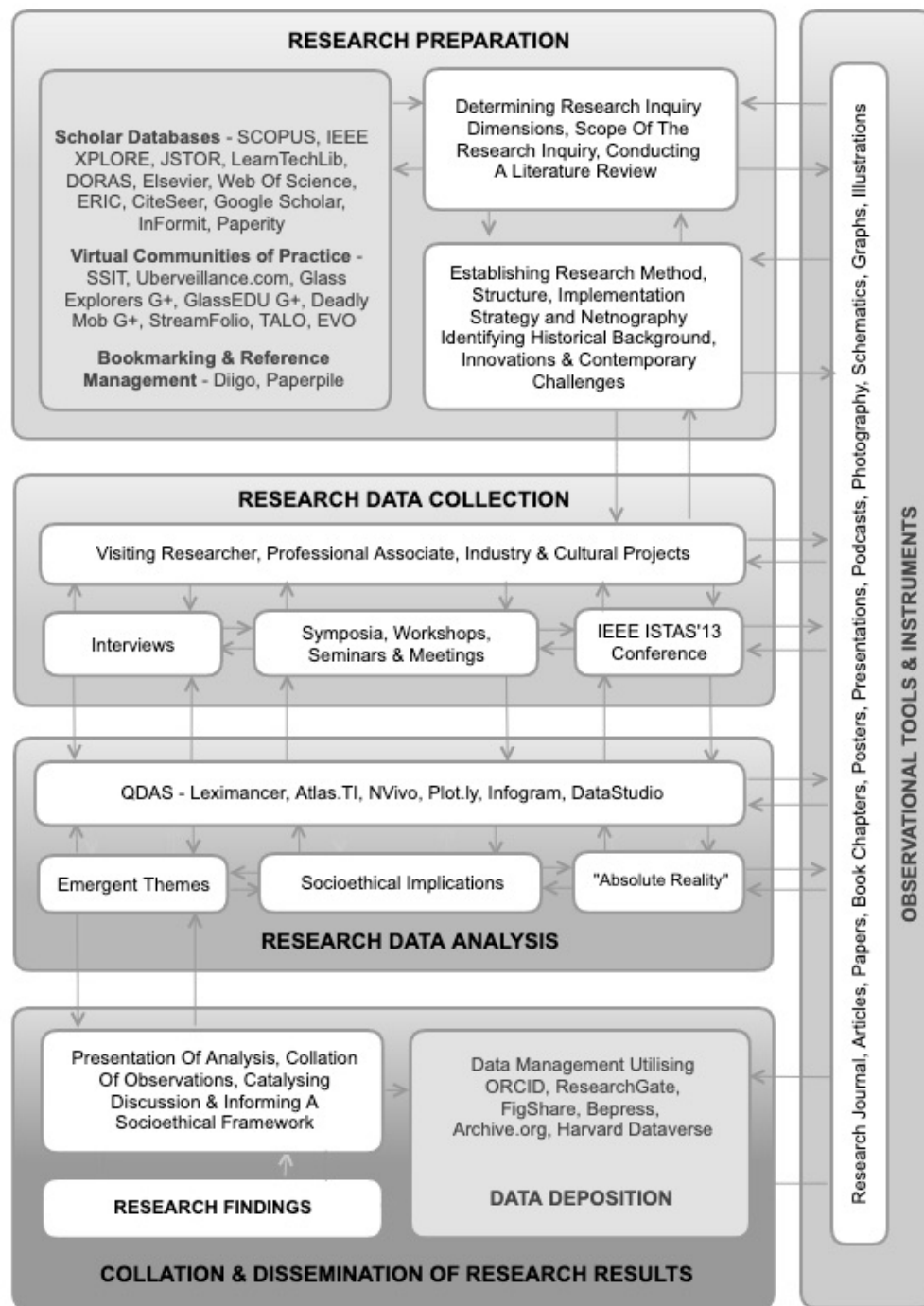


Figure 3. Research Outline: Detailed concurrent processes or 'stages' within the four phases of research investigation.
