

Research Data Management Teaching Toolkit Instructions

This teaching toolkit is designed to be used for a one hour introductory data management class for biomedical researchers. It consists of a PowerPoint presentation with a script in the accompanying notes to each slide, and a separate evaluation form. This material is built on the training material provided in the online research data management educational modules that are freely available here: http://bit.ly/RDM_Modules

Please note that while the presentation consists of 142 slides, we have found that it takes about one hour to present, as the slides are not text heavy and are meant to be moved through quickly.

You are free to use this material in whatever way you wish. This includes:

- Branding the slides for your institution
- Using a subset of the slides
- Changing visual display of slides
- Changing the order of slides
- Changing the script

In particular, **we encourage librarians to deliver the material using their own words.** The script is meant to serve as a starting point, and we hope that as people grow more comfortable with the material, they will make it more and more their own.
