


Cute Cut Pro Editing Introduction

1. Opening Screen

Once the app is opened you will see this screen. This is where the projects are stored. They are stored by the date they have been created.



2. Starting a new project.



Click on the + symbol in the top left of the screen to start a new project. A pop-up will prompt you to name your project.


3. The settings Screen.

This screen enables you to choose the project settings. This is the screen that automatically opens once you have created a new project and named it. Click done when settings are set.

This is how your screen should look when your project settings have been set. You are now ready to add clips and start editing your film.




The top right buttons are undo, settings, export and play.

Clicking on 'Movies' in the top left will take you back to the movie projects view.

5. Adding content to the timeline

The + symbol provides the options of content to choose from and add to the timeline for editing. Content is accessed from what is saved to the device, file-sharing options and via direct recording within the app. With Cute Cut Pro you can add video to two tracks, sound to numerous tracks, photo's to many tracks, record sound directly, add text and draw on frames. Ultimately a multi-layered timeline consisting of many tracks is possible with each track being able to be manipulated and edited further.




6. Adding video

You have two video tracks on the timeline. When you select video to add you have three options to select from; your albums, file sharing and camera, which enables direct recording. Mostly you will select what has been saved in albums.



Once a video has been selected, it will be inserted in the timeline.



Selecting the clip in the timeline will enable the editing tools to be accessed.


These tools enable the manipulation of the content in the timeline. You can alter transparency, speed, duration, size, duplicate, cut, mute and more. The editing tools in Cute Cut Pro enable the creation of polished video productions. The tools enable the manipulation of video, audio, transitions, text and drawing. In combination these tools provide access to infinite imaginative creations.

The following pages will highlight a few key tools to get you started. Once engaged let your imagination run wild.

A few editing tools to create interesting projects


1. Transitions

There are many transitions to choose from to add interest to videos. You need to click on the wand first before you can access the transitions options.




After you click on the wand, click here and a pop-up menu for transitions appears.

2. Copy, Paste, Trim and delete



3. Transparency


With multiple image layers, you can manipulate the transparency of certain layers to create interesting visuals.



Click on the sun symbol to access the percentage slider to alter transparency levels of visual tracks.

4. Manipulating time


You can speed up or slow down clips.



Click on the clock symbol to access the slider to manipulate the time of clips.

5. Drawing on clips


You can create mini animations in your projects by accessing the drawing tools and drawing step-by-step movements. When played back they are an animation. You can do this over static photos or even over video frames.



When you choose self-draw you can draw over the frame that is in in view. With many increments of self-draw you can create a small animation over the clips creating another layer in the video.

6. Layers and manipulating size of clips

Layers are an endless editing opportunity. You can resize an image layer by clicking on the layer and altering the resize handles in the time view.




7. Using text to create titles

You can create titles easily by choosing the text option. You type in the titles and when complete, you can choose the transition option to make the tiles more dynamic.



8. Exporting clips

You can share your finished project with Cute Cut Pro. You can share it via social media, save finished projects to your device, email clips or upload to your file-sharing cloud option.



To share projects, click on the share button in the top right hand corner and choose how you wish to share your finished project.
