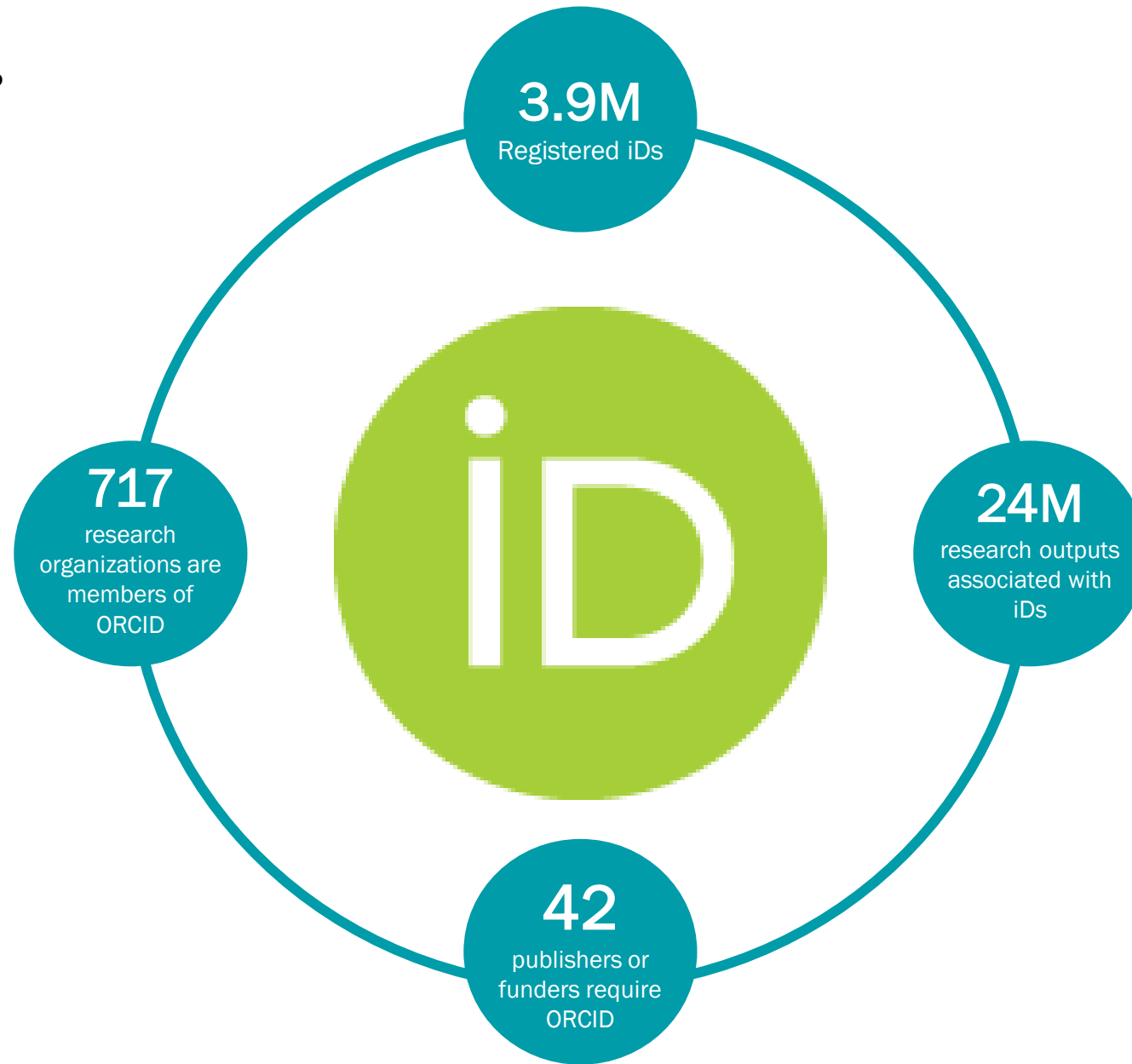

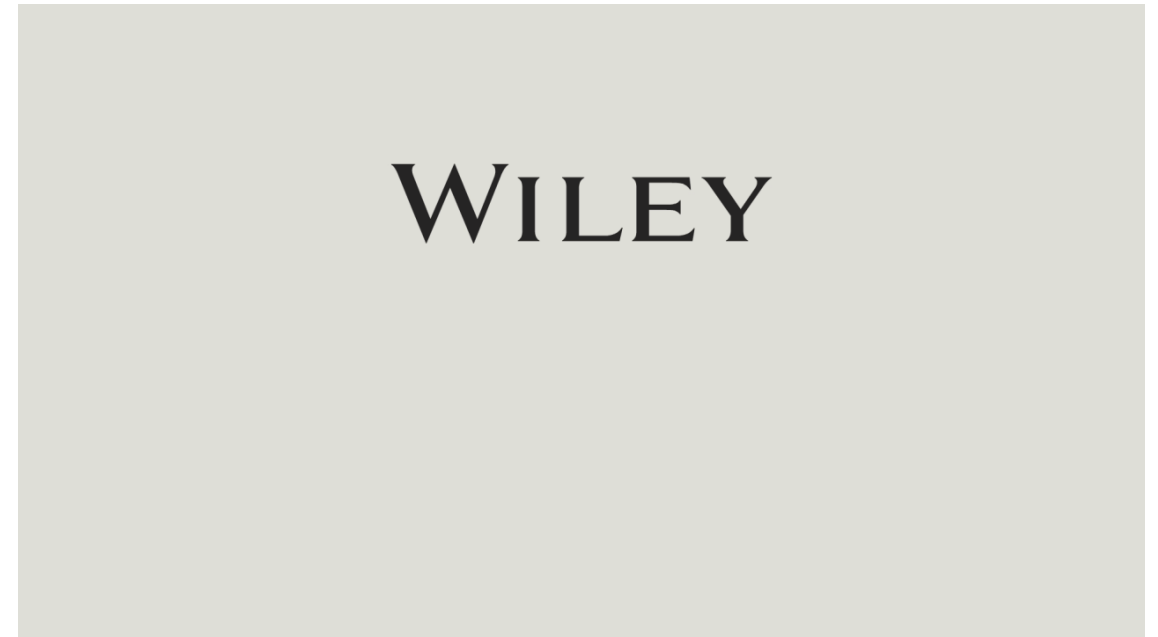
What is ORCID?



How does ORCID benefit researchers?

- Showcases work and increases discoverability, recognition and reward
- Reduces time spent reporting on past activities, allowing more time for research
- Easily connects existing grants, research activities and institutional affiliation
- Full privacy and control over ORCID record
- ORCID records can be automatically updated with each publication *

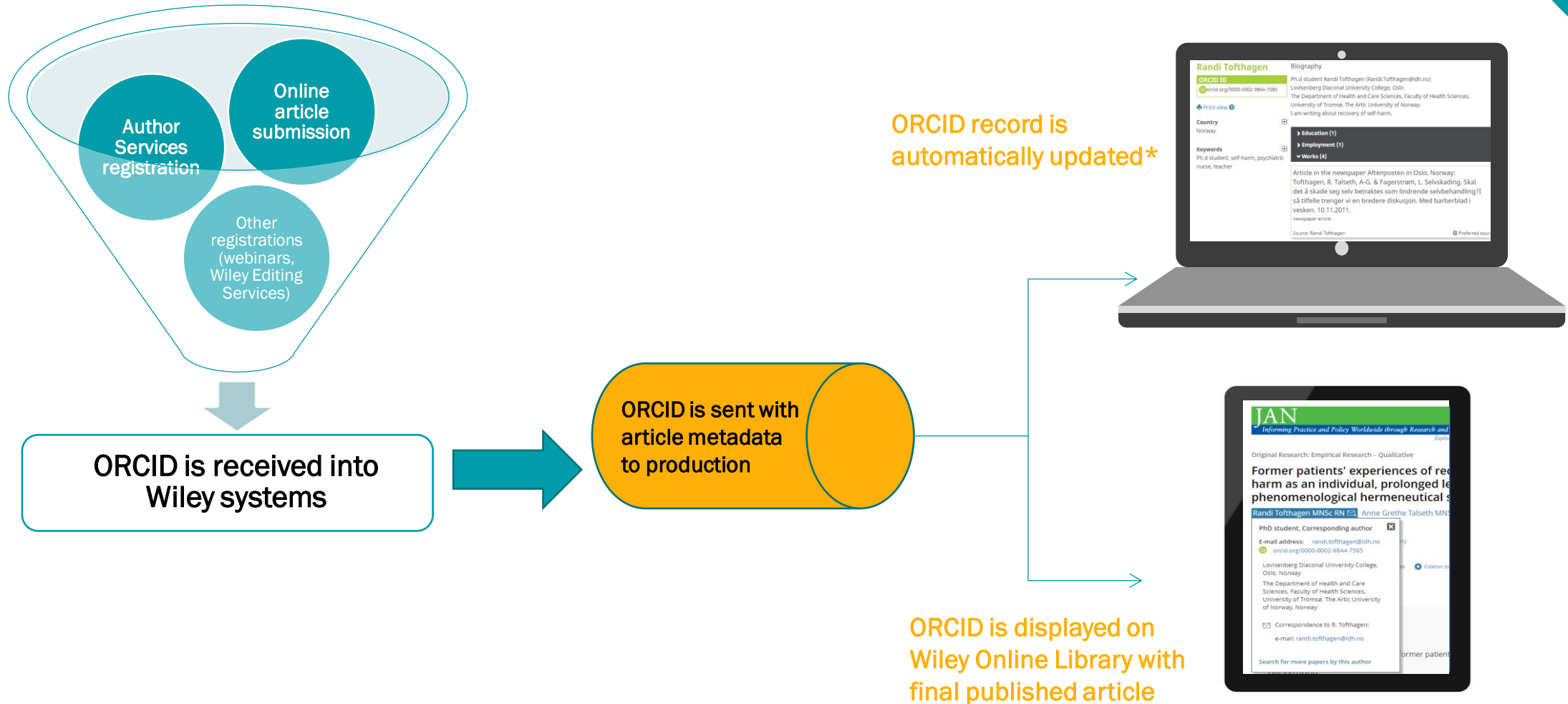
*ORCID record will be automatically updated if author gives Crossref permission to do so.

<Journal name> requires the submitting author (only) to provide an ORCID iD when submitting a manuscript.

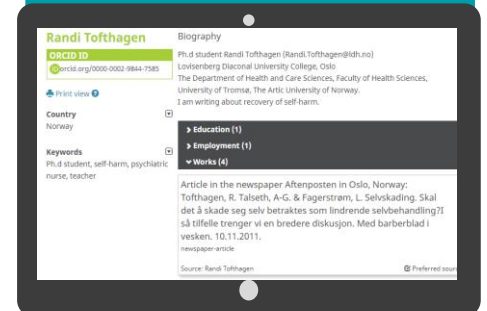

Why require ORCID?

What does it mean for authors?

Authors can connect all existing and new works and contributions in their ORCID record

Full compliance with funders that require ORCID, like Wellcome Trust and Swedish Research council

The ORCID record will be updated each time they publish an article*, creating more opportunities for reward and recognition

*ORCID record will be automatically updated if author gives Crossref permission to do so.

What are stakeholders doing?

Wiley was the first major publisher to require ORCID but other publishers are following

More than 50% of Wiley titles require ORCID as a condition for submission

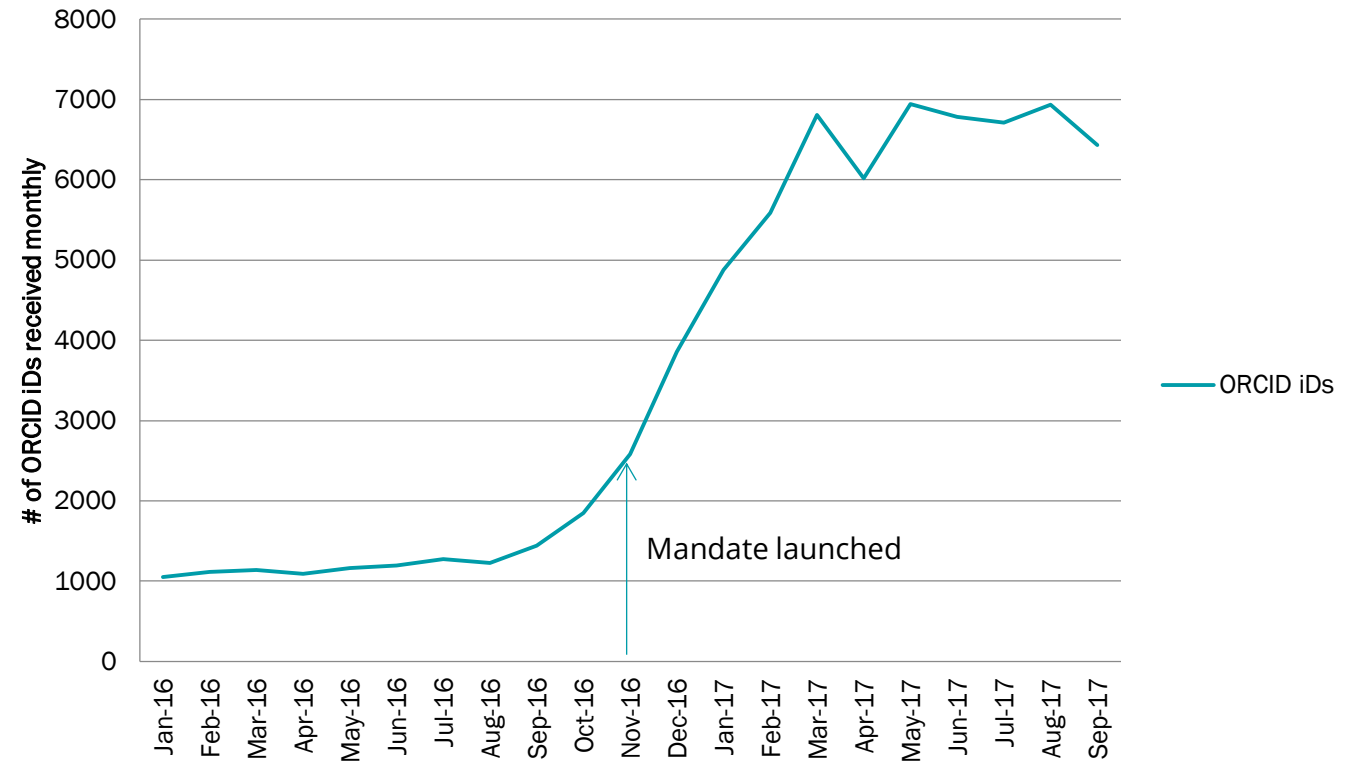
42 Publishers or funders, including Wellcome Trust, Austrian Science Fund, PLoS, RSC and Springer Nature, have signed [ORCID's open letter](#) to require it

Why require ORCID?

Where is Wiley now?

- 834 journals have adopted Wiley's recommended policy on ORCID
- Since January 2016, Wiley has received 76,313 unique ORCID iDs
 - 87% were received after the mandate launch

Total Unique ORCID iDs received monthly
