

Structured interview grid about the CREW knowledge exchange project

Telephone interview of about 15 minutes, themes and issues to be address with participants

1. CREW Day contributions

- First, can you describe briefly your experience of participating in CREW Day?

2. Changes in current teaching methods

- Can you tell me if things have changed since your participation in CREW DAY, for example in your teaching?
 - If necessary, clarify with: In your professional skills, in your teaching, your interest in ethics or knowledge?
- Have you made changes to your current course plan following (and related to) the CREW Day?
 - If so, what kind of changes? (teaching hours, subjects taught, learning objectives)
- Have you used new teaching methods in your classes following the CREW day?
- Have you incorporated new learning tools in your courses?
- Have you suggested new resources or tools to your students following the CREW day?
- Any other changes on an educational level?

3. Use of the 'Wiki' site

- Have you consulted the 'wiki' website on ethics education since it went online?
 - If yes
 - i. Approximately how many times have you used it?
 - ii. Have you made contributions to the 'wiki'? (i.e. write text or share information)
 - **If no, why not?**
- Did you like receiving the PDF format wiki and was this PDF helpful?
 - Make participant specify: was it useful a little, moderately, a lot... ?
- Do you have any comments on the appropriateness of this tool, or how to make it better?

4. Contacts created (networking / collaborations) after CREW Day

- Have you had contact or collaboration with the team or participants after the CREW Day?
 - If yes, what kind of collaborations? (academic, funds, research, publications, other) and please give details about these...
 - If no, what would have been required in order to create such collaborations?

5. Changes to approaches to ethics in rehabilitation

- Following the CREW Day last May, how has your perception of ethics teaching in rehabilitation changed?

6. Answers to expectations

- Did we meet your expectations on this knowledge exchange project?
 - If yes, how?
 - If no, why not?

7. Changes at the institutional level

- Have there been changes at your institution regarding the offered ethics courses, or have you asked for changes to be made to the organization of ethics courses at your institution?

8. General comments

- Do you have any general comments to us on your participation in the CREW Day, the Day itself, or on ways to improve for future projects?
 - [This question might already have been answered by the other questions in the questionnaire, so only ask if pertinent and if not answered yet...]

9. Future collaborations

- Would you be interested in participating in future projects on the teaching of ethics in rehabilitation?
 - What type of project would be of interest for you?
