Preliminaries

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Upper ontologies seek to provide a domain independant way of classifying any type of object. Proponents of their use seek a consistent way of classifying objects and their classes within an ontology. Such upper ontologies are conceptually complex and are often seen as hard to use. This research study addresses this issue by adapting a well-known form of knowledge ellicitation to generate a set of ordered questions the answers to which will guide a user of an upper ontology to place a class of objects correctly under that upper ontology. The study will use the "20 questions" knowledge elicitation approach in which a knowledge engineer has an object in his or her mind and the domain expert asks a series of yes/no questions in order to identify the object. The questions and their ordering then give the essential criteria for recognising that type of object and the place in which it belongs within the ontology. In this study the domain expert will be an expert in the Basic Formal Ontology (BFO) a widely used upper ontology. The aim is to find the set of questions that will quide an ontology user to classify classes of objects correctly under BfO. The study wil be in three parts: 1) Creating a baseline "gold standard" of classified objects made by BFO experts by which the effectiveness of the set of questions can be judged; 2 Asking BFO experts to ask a series of yes/no questions in order to identify the series of objects used in part (1) 3) Using the set of questions generated in part (3) with a set of ontology authors to evaluate the effectiveness of this question answering technique as a means of classifying classes of objects under BFO.

Study Details:

The first step in this investigation is to create a gold-standard set of classifications of objects under BFO 1.1 and a baseline of agreement that our technique would have to achieve. For this first stage we seek your help to take a set of objects from the domain of travel and classify them under BFO 1.1. We will take your and others' classification to form our gold-standard and agreement level that will form the foundation of this investigation.

This study has been approved by the ethics committee at the University of Manchester, UK. All data is held securely in a data repository located at the University of Manchester. Published results will not include individual names or email addresses, or any other personal meta-data. For more information about the experiment data, see the <u>personal information sheet</u>.
