



WHAT IS ORCID?

- An identifier for researchers
- A registry
- •A set of standard procedures (APIs) for connecting researchers to their affiliations and activities
- •A committed community building connectors
- •An international-scale open research effort



THE ORCID COMMUNITY

- 935 members from 43 countries
- 550+ system connectors: all research sectors
- Over 5.5 million researchers
- Consortia in:
 - Americas: Brazil, Canada & United States
 - EMEA: UK, Norway, Finland, Sweden, Netherlands, Belgium, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Israel, South Africa
 - APAC: Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan



ORCID IN EMEA

- 503 members organizations (of 935 globally)
- 283 active integrations (of 557 globally)
- 11 national/regional consortia (of 18 globally)
- 33 Collect & Connect Badges awarded
- 39% of registry usage

Mandating the use of Open Researcher and Contributor ID (ORCID) by submitting authors.

ORCID provides a unique identifier for all researchers that can be linked to their different research works and activities across multiple platforms. It also serves to distinguish authors with similar names and simplify searching of publications databases (such as PubMed, Scopus, etc.) to avoid retrieving articles by authors with similar names. Close to 1.8 million researchers have already created their ORCID iD. The service is non-profit and community driven.




From 1 January 2016, we will require the submitting author to provide an ORCID identifier as part of the manuscript submission process. Details of the practicalities will be provided shortly, but don't worry, it takes less than a minute to register for an ORCID iD and it's free of charge. A recent survey carried out by ORCID indicates strong support in the research community for mandates by publishers, funders, and universities.

Benefits of creating an ORCID iD

1. It's a time saver

ORCID provides a unique digital identifier, which distinguishes you from other researchers with similar names and also brings together any variant spellings of your name. It supports authentication across multiple journals, search engines and services, allowing you a single sign-on.



- Over 2,561 sources (publisher systems) currently collect ORCID iD
- 61 publishers have signed the open letter to date to require ORCID iDs during submission

INFRASTRUCTURE

Infrastructure: ORCID as a trusted neutral actor in sharing research information

 ORBIT Project: establish what information is essential for funding applications and post-award reporting, and demonstrate how funders can engage with researchers to use ORCID record information to populate funder forms



REPOSITORY TASKFORCE

This group is charged with reviewing and providing feedback on the proposed recommendations for supporting ORCID in repository systems, including considering:

- At what points in repository workflows are ORCID iDs most useful/relevant?
- What are the current challenges in using ORCID in repositories?
- What ORCID features would be most helpful to include in a repository platform?
















Evidence of Institutional Value

UK: 0.2 – 0.4 FTEs per institution¹

Portugal: 100,000 researcher hours per year²

Australia: 15-30 minutes per grant application³




