



ORCID in Europe, Middle East & Africa










WEBSITE VISITS* — TOP 5 COUNTRIES

DID YOU KNOW THAT?

- Researchers in Western Europe are most likely to have added works to their ORCID record
- Researchers in Africa and the Middle East are most likely to agree that ORCID saves them time
- African researchers are most likely to agree that an ORCID iD is essential

- Middle Eastern researchers are most likely to want to connect anything they make public with their name on to their ORCID record
- African researchers are most likely to see ORCID as innovative
- East European researchers are most likely to see ORCID as global
- African researchers are most likely to agree that requiring ORCID iDs is beneficial to the global research community
