Training offer – examples of domains taught






1,277 trainees 22 SIB groups involved







Identify new and continuing needs for courses

- SIB group leaders & members









Balance: diversity of topics, levels, geographical locations






Course outline following best practices

- Target audience: Knowledge level, prerequisites, background
- Learning outcomes (LO)
 - Bloom's taxonomy
- Select and develop content relevant to LO
- Select learning experiences that will best lead to LO
- Design assessments to measure if LO are achieved






Take home messages
