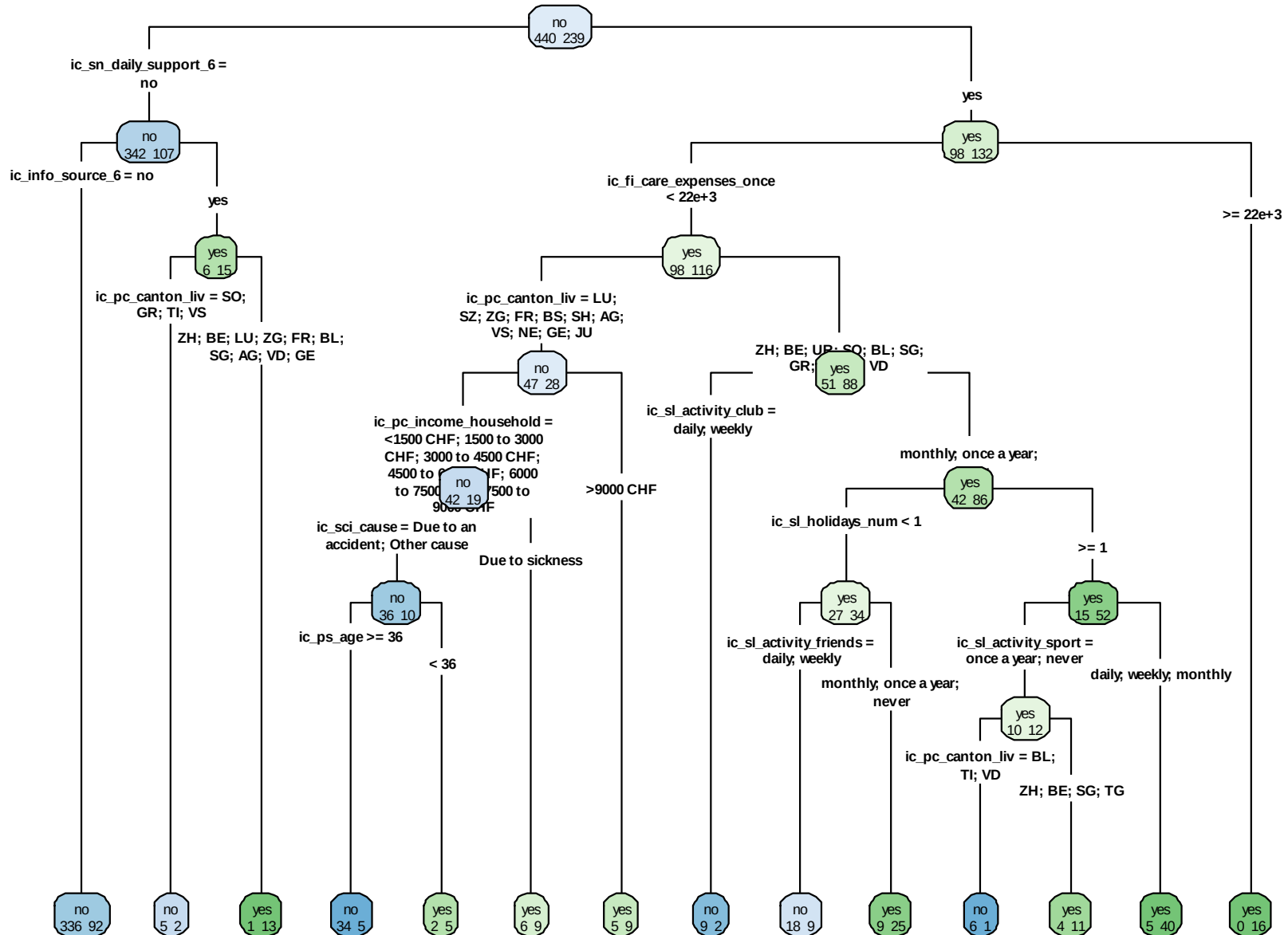
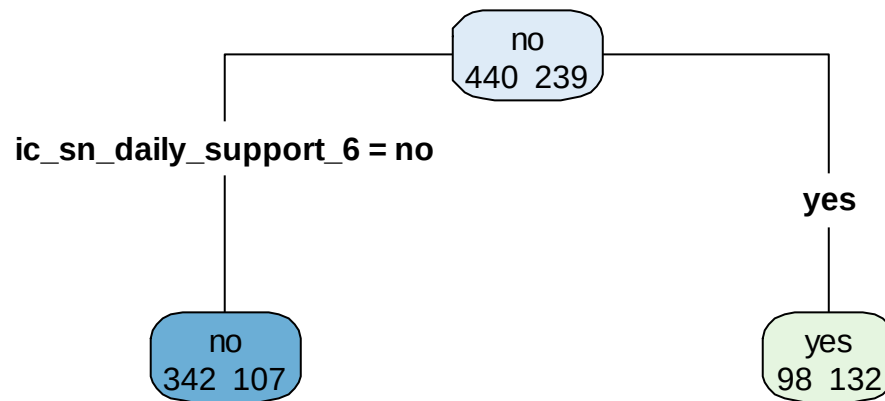

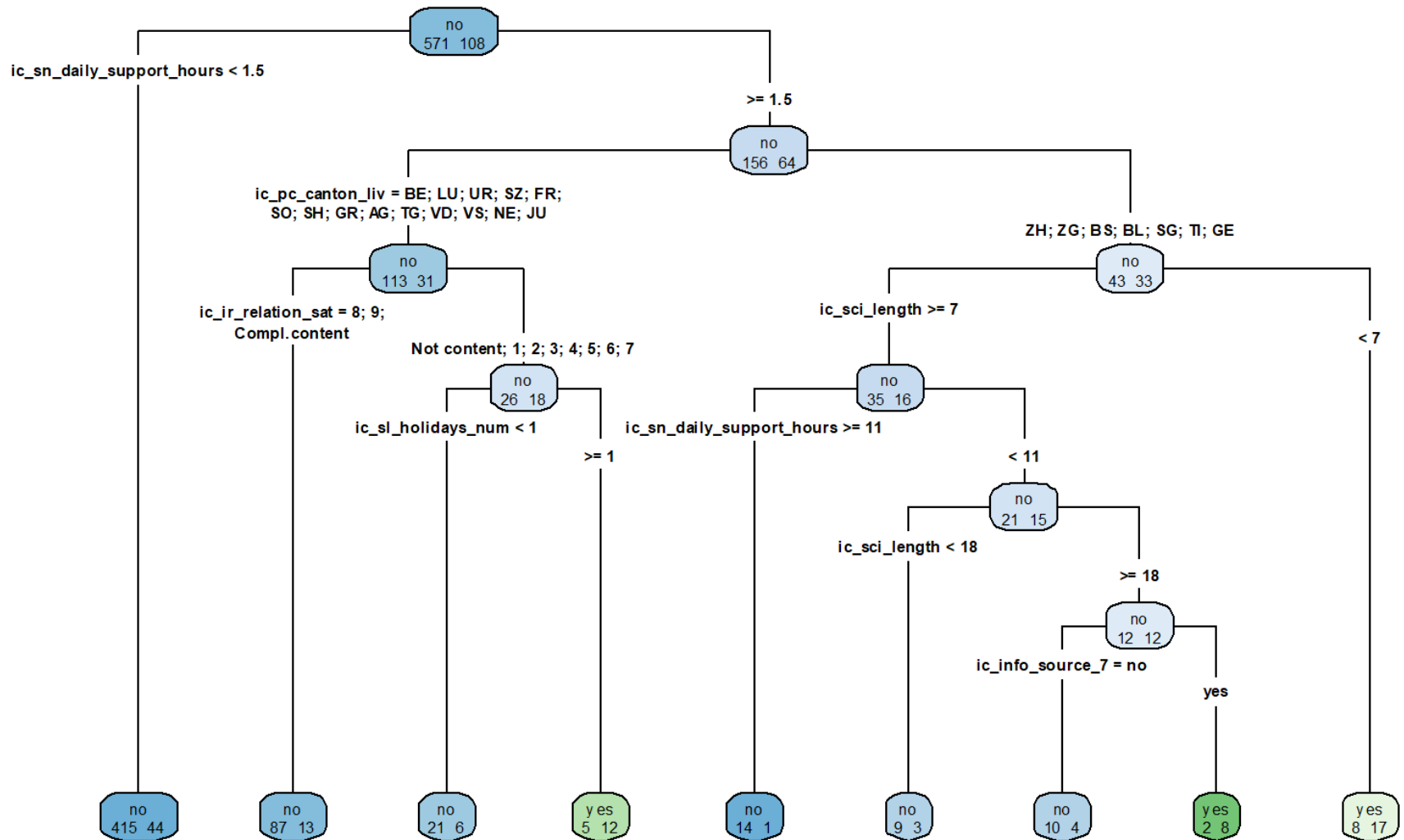
Use of at least one type of respite care



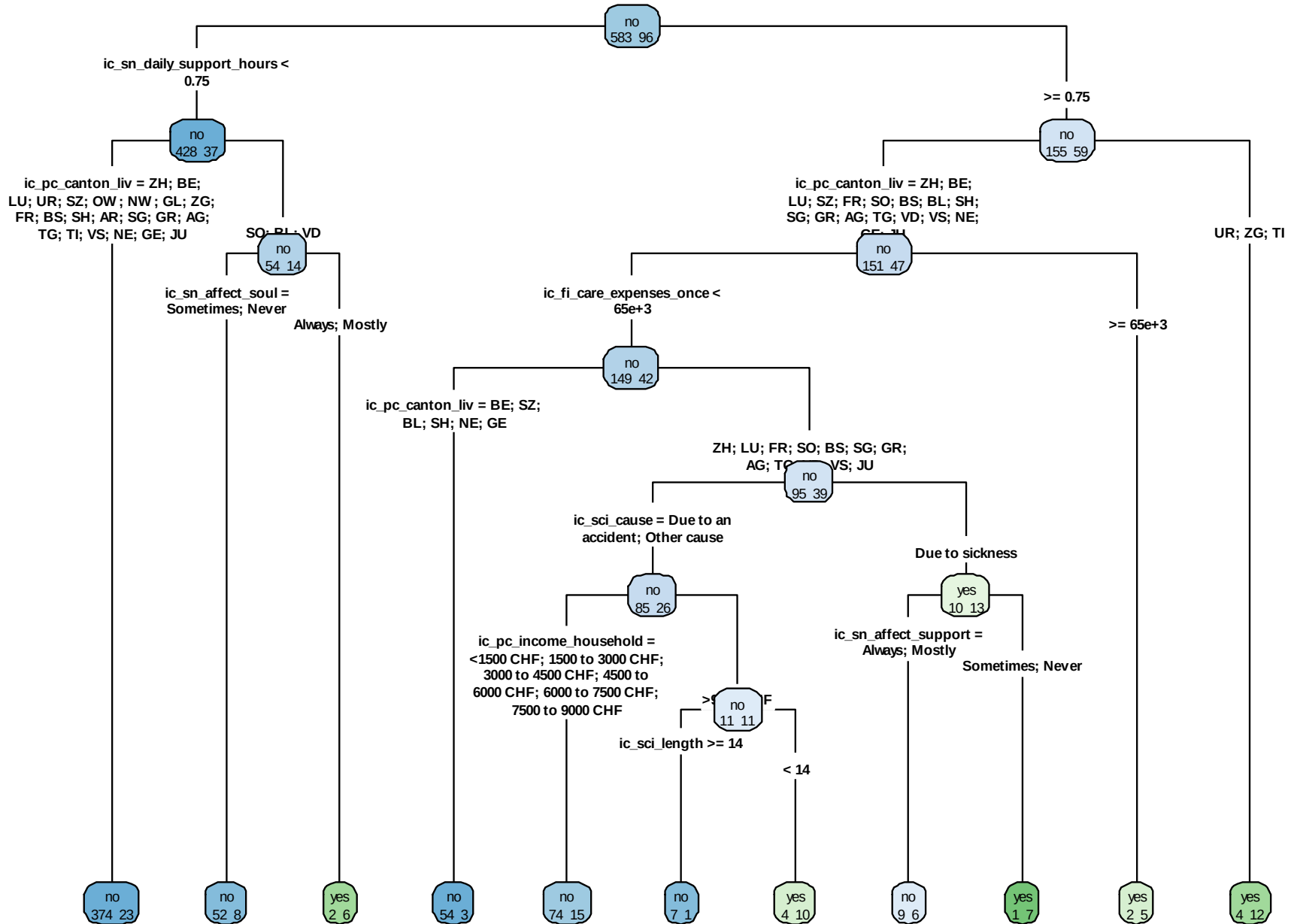
Use of at least one type of respite (pruned)



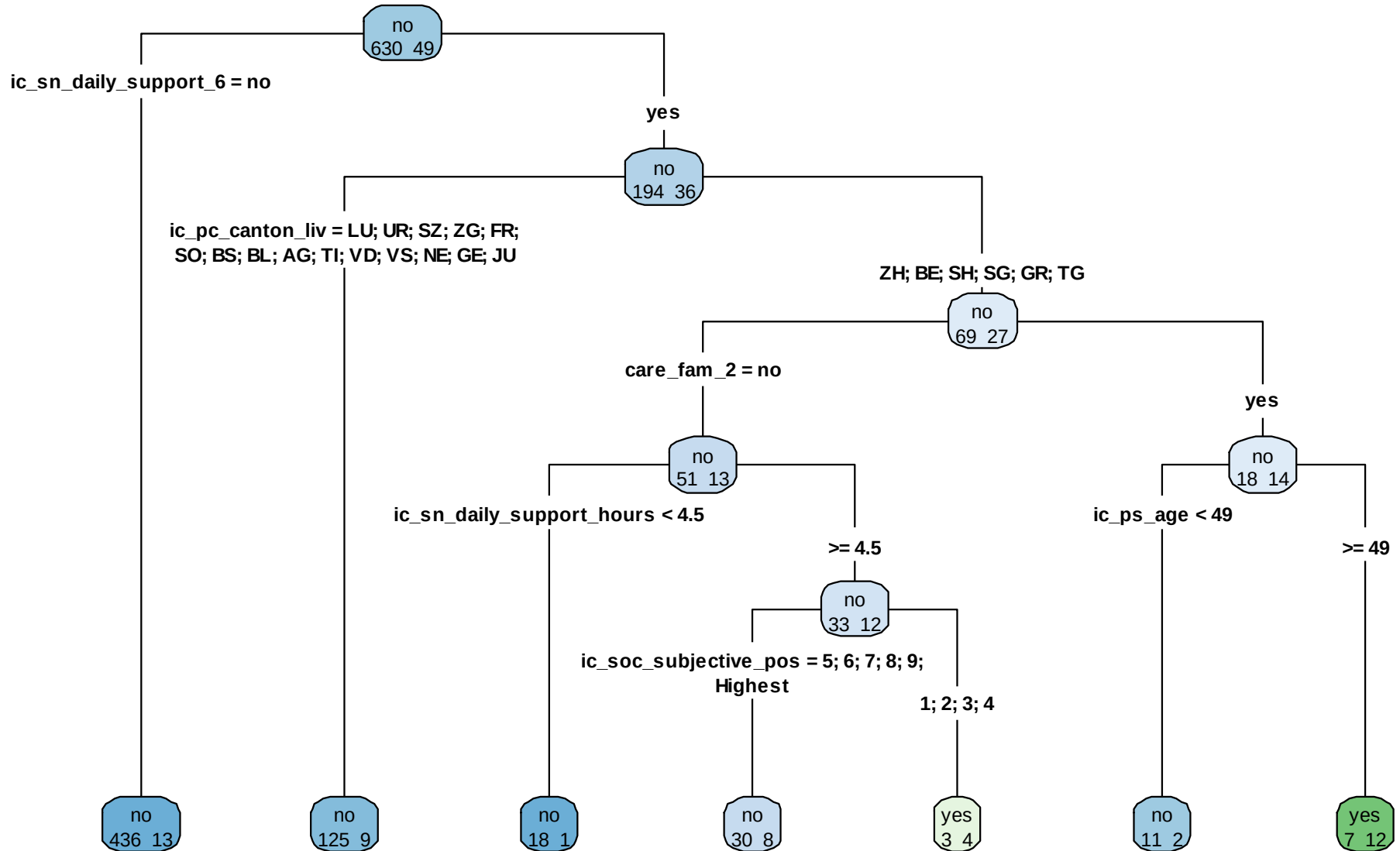
Use of driving service



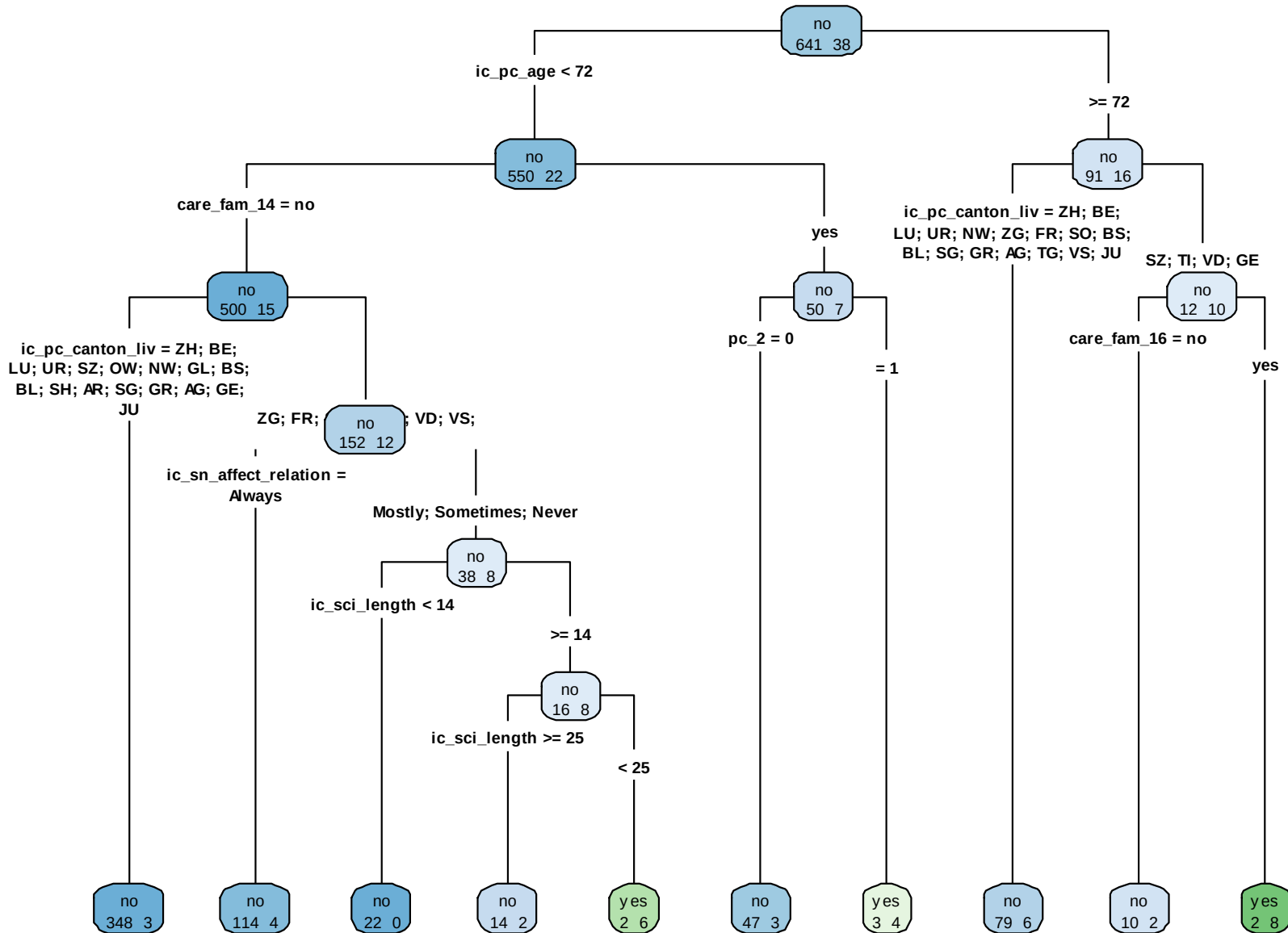

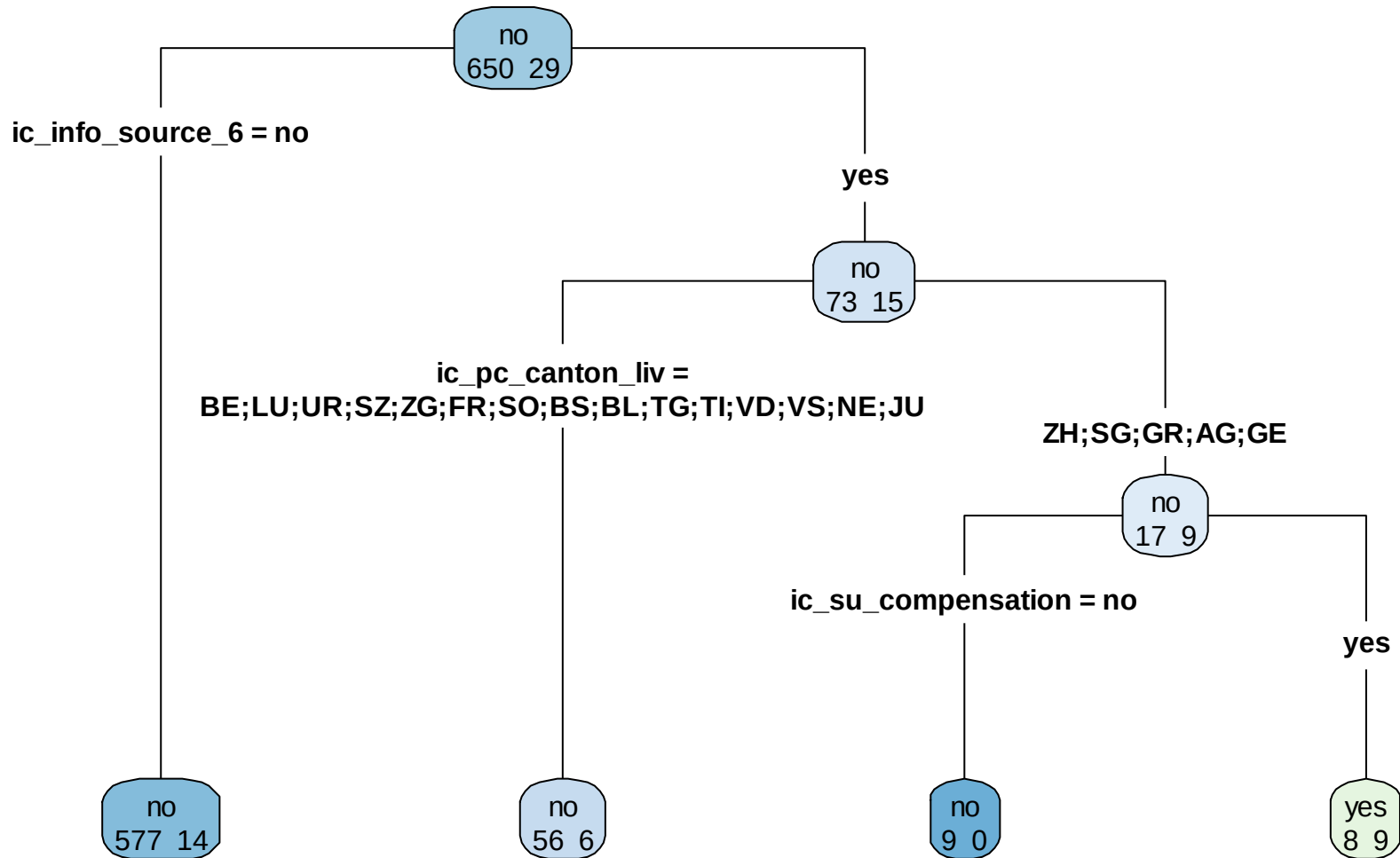

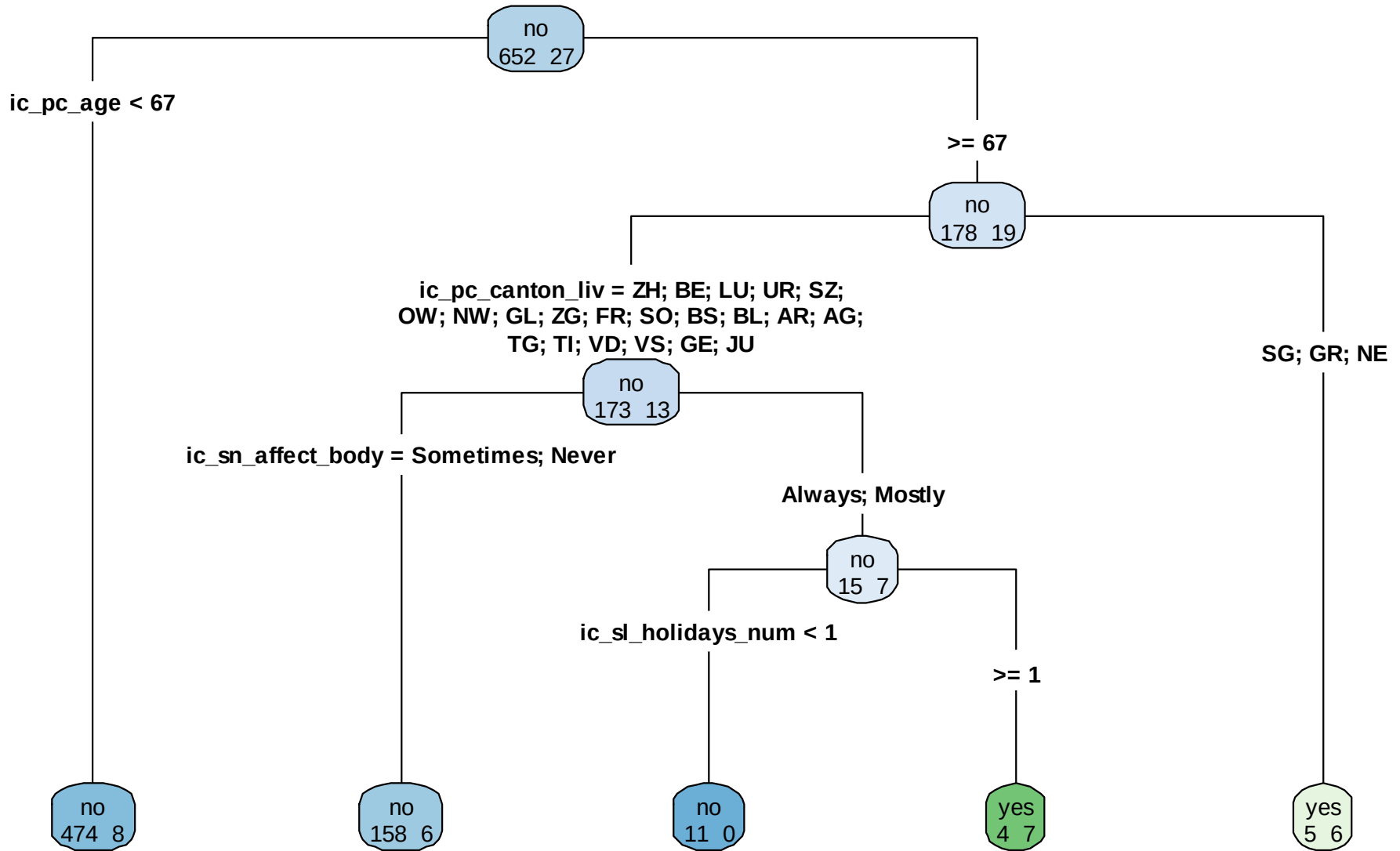

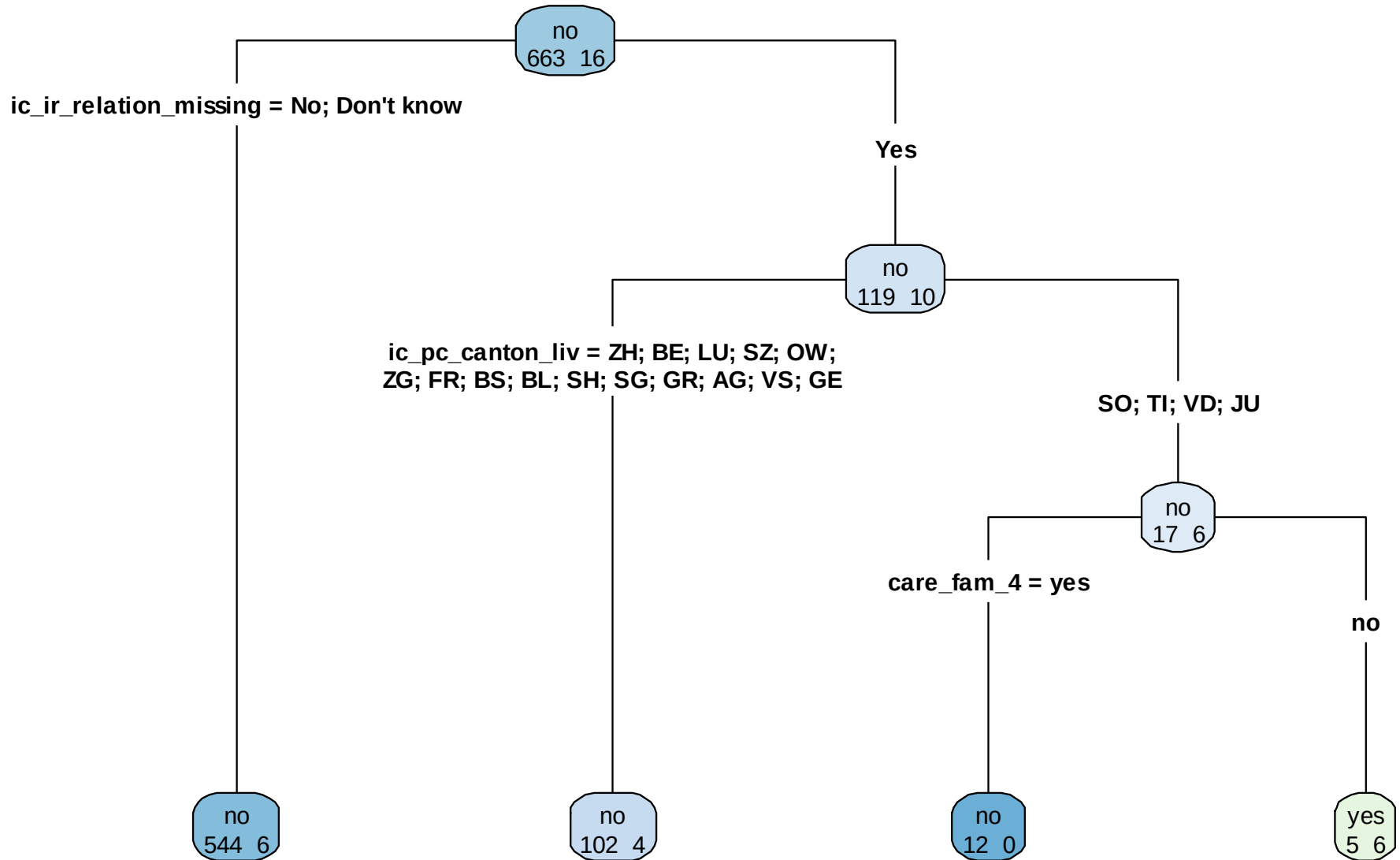
Use of respite assistance at home during the day

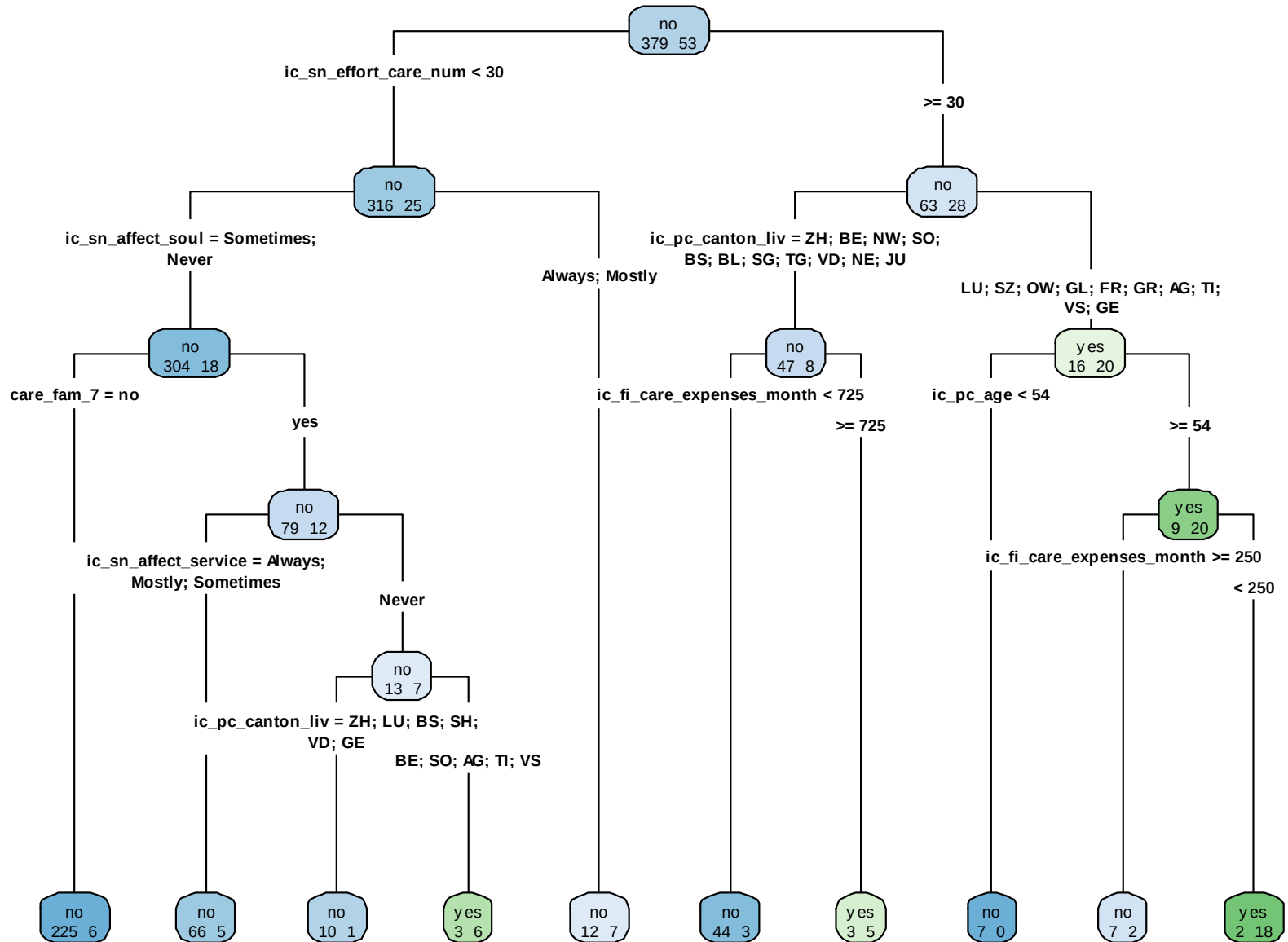
Non-use because of no demand (pruned)



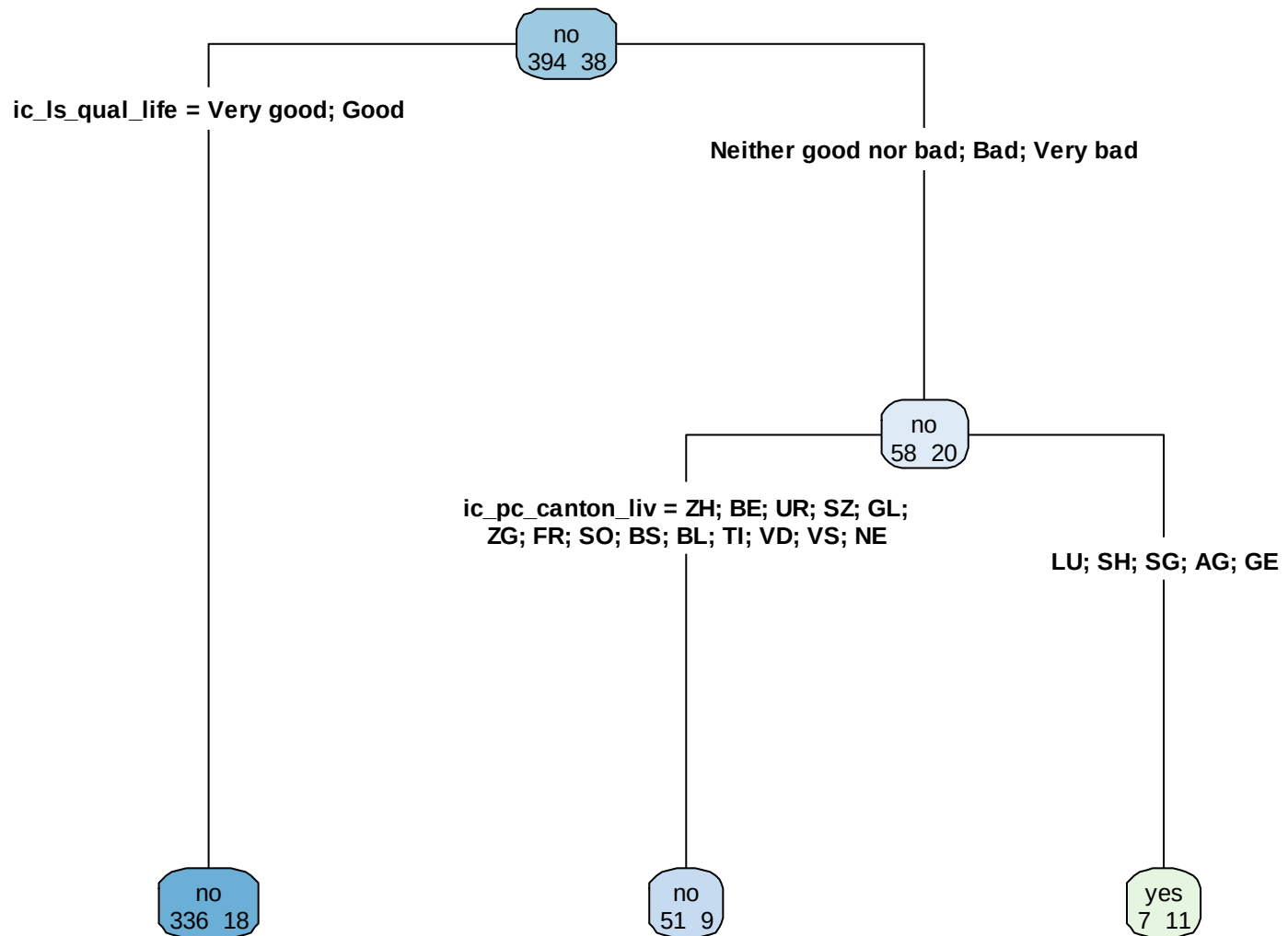
Non-use because of sufficient support by friends and family
