
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

**Supplementary Figure S1.** Histograms of cleaned and quality controlled GBIF data, indicating the frequency of species records available per (a) calendar year (b) sampling method (c) and life-stage. Dashed vertical lines on panel (a) represent years of significant data collection efforts; CPR = Continuous Plankton Recorder, IPY = International Polar Year, GLOBEC = Global Ocean Ecosystems Dynamics. Due to a high number of categories, only those with more than 50 (b) and 1000 (c) occurrences were included.



**Supplementary Figure S2.** Histograms of cleaned and quality controlled OBIS data, indicating the frequency of species records available via per (a) calendar year (b) sampling method (c) and life-stage. Dashed vertical lines on panel (a) represent years of significant data collection efforts; CPR = Continuous Plankton Recorder, IPY = International Polar Year, GLOBEC = Global Ocean Ecosystems Dynamics. Due to a high number of categories, only those with more than 200 occurrences were included in plots b-c.
